#### ITEM 1.01 ENTRY INTO A MATERIAL DEFINITIVE AGREEMENT.

On June 27, 2012, Dollar General Corporation (the Company) and certain of its subsidiaries, as guarantors (the Subsidiary Guarantors), entered into an Underwriting Agreement (the Underwriting Agreement), dated as **bti**ne 27, 2012, with Citigroup Global Markets Inc., Goldman, Sachs & Co., and KKR Capital Markets LLC (the Representatives, and together with the other underwriters named in Schedule I thereto, the Underwriters) with respect to the Company s issuance and sale of \$500,000,000 aggregate principal amount of 4.125% Senior Notes due 2017 (the New Notes). Settlement for the offering of the New Notes is expected to occur on July 12, 2012. The net proceeds from the offering of the New Notes will be used, together with cash on hand, to redeem all outstanding aggregate principal amount of the Company s 11.8725%/12.625% senior subordinated toggle notes due 2017 (the Existing Notes).

The sale of the New Notes was made pursuant to the Company's and the Subsidiary Guarantors Registration Statement on Form S-3, as amended (Registration No. 333-165800) (the Registration Statement), including a prospectus supplement dated no 27, 2012 (the Prospectus Supplement) to the prospectus contained therein dated March 31, 2010 (the Base Prospectus), filed by the Company with the Securities and Exchange Commission, pursuant to Rule 424(b)(2) under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, and a free writing prospectus dated June 27, 2012, filed by the Company with the Securities and Exchange Commission, pursuant to Rule 433 under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended.

The Underwriting Agreement contains customary representations, warranties and covenants and includes the terms and conditions for the sale of the New Notes, indemnification and contribution obligations and other terms and conditions customary in agreements of this type.

Each of Goldman, Sachs & Co. and an affiliate of Kohlberg Kravis Roberts & Co. L.P. acted as an Underwriter for the New Notes offering. Kohlberg Kravis Roberts & Co. L.P. and Goldman, Sachs & Co., through their investment in Buck Holdings, L.P., are significant shareholders of the Company. Certain of the underwriters and/or their affiliates are holders of the Existing Notes and will receive a portion of the net proceeds from the offering of the New Notes.

Certain of the Underwriters or their affiliates perform and have performed commercial and investment banking and advisory services for the Company from time to time for which they receive and have received customary fees and expenses. The Underwriters may, from time to time, engage in transactions with and perform services for the Company in the ordinary course of their business for which they will receive fees and expenses.
