RSUs granted in April 2011 resulted in the right to receive 6,000 shares of Common Stock. In respect of the PSUs granted in April 2008 with respect to fiscal year 2009, on April 28, 2009, the reporting person earned the right to receive 7,200 shares of Common Stock. The reporting person was associated with the Issuer on April 28, 2009, resulting in the vesting and issuance of 1,800 of the 7,200 shares of Common Stock so earned. On April 27, 2010, the reporting person continued to be

(6) associated with the Issuer, resulting in the vesting and issuance of another 1,800 shares of Common Stock so earned. On April 26, 2011, the reporting person continued to be associated with the Issuer, resulting in the vesting and issuance of another 1,800 shares of Common Stock so earned. On May 3, 2012, the reporting person continued to be associated with the Issuer, resulting in the vesting and issuance of the remaining 1,800 shares of Common Stock so earned.

In respect of the PSUs granted in April 2009 with respect to fiscal year 2010, on April 27, 2010, the reporting person earned the right to receive 11,250 shares of Common Stock. The reporting person was associated with the Issuer on April 27, 2010, resulting in the vesting and issuance of 2,813 of the 11,250 shares of Common Stock so earned. On April 26, 2011, the reporting person continued to be associated with the Issuer, resulting in the vesting and issuance of another 2,813 shares of Common Stock so earned. On May 3, 2012, the reporting person continued to be associated with the Issuer, resulting in the vesting and issuance of another 2,813 shares of Common Stock so earned. The remaining 2,811 shares have been earned, but are not yet vested.

In respect of the PSUs granted in April 2010 with respect to fiscal year 2011, on April 26, 2011, the reporting person earned the right to receive 3,750 shares of Common Stock. The reporting person was associated with the Issuer on April 26, 2011, resulting in the vesting and issuance of 938 of the 3,750 shares of Common Stock so earned. These RSUs will vest and the underlying shares of Common Stock will be issued in equal annual installments of 1,500 shares commencing on or about May 1, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015, generally subject to the reporting person's continued association with the Issuer on the date such shares of Common Stock are to be issued. The reporting person was associated with the Issuer on May 3, 2012, resulting in the vesting and issuance of 1,500 of the 6,000 shares of Common Stock covered by the RSU. The remaining 4,500 remain subject to issuance upon future vesting.
