On August 12, 2008, NII Holdings, Inc. (the Company) announced plans to implement changes in the responsibilities of certain officers in the Company's controllership and treasury functions, appointing Catherine E. Neel, who currently serves as the Company's vice president, treasurer and assistant secretary, as the Company's vice president and controller (chief accounting officer) and Daniel E. Freiman, who currently serves as the Company's vice president and controller, as the Company's vice president and treasurer. The appointments to the new positions will become effective on October 1, 2008.

Ms. Neel, 47, has served as the Company's vice president, treasurer and assistant secretary since November 2002. From 1999 to 2002, she was the Company's assistant treasurer. Prior to 1999, Ms. Neel held various management positions with Bellsouth Corporation and was in public accounting with Arthur Andersen LLP.

Mr. Freiman, 36, has been the Company's vice president and controller since April 2005. He was the Company's director of investor relations from June 2004 to April 2005, director of external financial reporting from November 2002 to June 2004, and senior manager of external financial reporting from September 2000 to November 2002. Prior to September 2000, he was a manager in the audit practice of PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP in Washington, D.C.

In their new roles, both Ms. Neel and Mr. Freiman will continue to report directly to Gokul Hemmady, the Company's vice president and chief financial officer.
